The Authority of the Borough of Charleroi is now accepting resumes to fill a temporary position within the Authority. The successful candidate will begin employment in the Water Distribution Department. If the position becomes permanent, the individual may be offered fulltime employment and, in the future, could be assigned to either the Water Treatment Plant or Sewage Treatment Plant.

Example of Duties

- Assists or performs a variety of cleaning, maintenance and repair work on water/wastewater equipment, systems, vehicles and tools as needed.
- Operates and drives assigned vehicles as needed to provide effective and safe services to customers.
- Installs, troubleshoots, and repairs water distribution or wastewater collection system facilities.
- Installs, repairs, and replaces water mains, valves, service lines, and hydrants or sewer lines and manholes.
- Navigate SCADA system and interpret data used for monitoring Plant and System Operations.
- Communicates with customers to satisfy customer inquiries and complaints.
- Perform restoration work including, but not limited to, concrete, asphalt, and landscape.

Work Environment

- Night and weekend call-outs for emergency repairs.
- Exposure to inclement weather at times.
- Work may occur in confined spaces as well as in elevated areas in excess of 50 feet.
- Exposure to hazardous chemicals and environments at the Treatment Plants.
- Shift work at the Water Treatment Plant to provide 24 hour coverage.

Qualifications

- Possess a high school diploma or GED. Post-secondary education or trade school is preferred but not a requirement.
- Obtain proper certification from the PA DEP for job position.
 - Candidates already possessing a Water or Wastewater certification are preferred.
- Must pass a controlled substance test (drug and alcohol) and have a clear criminal history.
- Possesses a valid driver's license and clean driving record.
- Ability to establish and maintain good working relationships with other employees, customers, contractors and others.
- Ability to perform heavy labor, including but not limited to, standing, bending, reaching, digging, walking long distances, and climbing ladders.
- Ability to lift, move, and carry equipment weighing up to 100 lbs.
- Ability to understand the operation of pumps, valves, motors, and other mechanical equipment related to operations and maintenance.
- Ability to learn on the job, organize and complete daily paperwork, read and understand written and verbal instructions and daily work orders.
